One Health, MT

Tiffany Klein absolutely emulates the behaviors expected in an Outstanding Advocate of the Underserved, in her lifestyle as well as in her role at One Health. Tiffany is employed as a Community Health Advocate for One Health in Miles City, Montana, a role that supports the resource needs of the community's most vulnerable patients. She helps individuals navigate social systems and barriers to care to improve their health and general wellbeing. In this role, Tiffany works hard to initiate and maintain community connections to improve patient outcomes.

Tiffany spearheaded the design and implementation process of One Health's first patient garden. After recognizing the need for improved access to healthy foods and social outlets, she completed a design and requested donated funds. She donated hours of her time building raised garden beds to get the project going, and obtained donated rain gutters and a barrel to harvest rainwater. Patients are able to participate in the physical activity of tending the garden while engaging in healthy social interactions as well. The patient garden has become a fantastic outlet for many patients and plans to improve the garden next year are underway.

Outside of work, Tiffany serves as the Board President of the community soup kitchen, volunteering countless hours to the underserved. This wonderful individual provides outstanding services while advocating for the underserved in her rural community.
