### EXAM ROOM POSTERS

#### **Antibiotics Posters (2001)\* – Laminated 8.5" x 11"**

These posters highlight the reasons why clinicians do not routinely prescribe antibiotics for viral infections. They are available in Spanish and English.

#### **Colorectal Cancer Screening Posters (2018)\* – Laminated 8.5" x 11"**

These posters encourage patients to ask their provider about colorectal cancer screening. They are available in English and English/Spanish.

### CLINICAL REFERENCE/POCKET CARDS

#### **Medical Spanish Pocket Card Set (2006-2007) – Laminated, 3.75" x 7.25"**

These two double-sided bound cards, produced by Borm Bruckmeier Publishing, provide medical terms, common questions, body parts, greetings, and exam terminology in English and Spanish.

#### **Oral Health Pocket Card (2015)\* – Laminated 3.75" x 7"**

This card details normal tooth eruption dates, treatment for avulsed permanent teeth, oral and head/neck cancer examination, common prescriptions for dental problems, and American Dental Association pain management guidelines.

#### **Prescribing in Spanish Pocket Card (2015)\* – Laminated 4" x 8"**

This card, produced by CHAMPS, provides phrases in English and Spanish related to prescribing medications, such as how to's, frequencies, cautions, and warnings.

#### **Screening, Brief Intervention, Referral to Treatment (SBIRT) for Alcohol Use Pocket Card (2008) – Laminated 3.25" x 4.25"**

This double-sided reference card, provided by SBIRT Colorado, provides SBIRT program guidelines including questions to ask, criteria for a positive screen, healthy range of use, etc.

### WELLNESS PAGES

#### **Patient Education Handouts (2019)\* – Color, Double Sided 8.5"x11"**

These have been developed to support the preventive care provided by health centers, allowing patients to anticipate what may be discussed at a wellness visit and encourage them to select the items that they wish to discuss with their care team. Available age levels include: Teens, Women 18-49, Women 50-64, Women 65+, Men 18-64, and Men 65+.

### PATIENT EDUCATION VIDEO/DVD – BABY BOTTLE TOOTH DECAY (2001)

**Baby Bottle Tooth Decay** is 16 minutes long, and is available in English and Spanish on video, and in English on DVD. The presentation is designed to help parents understand the importance of proper dental care. It educates parents on implementing a beneficial oral health regimen with the active participation of their children, and covers early detection and prevention, the impact of sugars, healthy snack suggestions, proper use of fluoride, and proper brushing and flossing techniques.
