Campaign Background

In 2015 more than 900 health center staff members, community health workers, clinicians, executives, consumer board members, and advocates agreed to collaborate together to develop more effective strategies to increase access to care for Migrant & Seasonal Agricultural Workers (Ag Workers) and their families over the next five years.

Campaign Goals

1) To serve not less than 2 million Ag Workers and their families nationally by 2020.
