To assure easy return, a postage paid, pre-addressed envelope will be included with the borrowed resources.

All Other Organizations may borrow items for up to four (4) weeks by completing and submitting this form and mailing a non-refundable fee (as listed next to each resource on the reverse of this form) to CHAMPS. For items not returned by the due date, CHAMPS will place a courtesy call and send an email reminder. If the items are not returned after that time, CHAMPS will bill the borrower a non-return charge for the item (charges are detailed on the reverse of this form).
