The health centers within the Bureau of Primary Health Care (BPHC) **Health Center Program** provide affordable, comprehensive, high-quality primary health care services in a wide range of communities, from inner cities to rural expanses, focusing on meeting the needs of the people and areas they serve. As of 2025 there are over **1,525** health centers operating in the United States, serving **34.4 million** people. These include community health centers, school-based health centers, look-alike health centers, and more. Each of these health centers must:

Be located in an area of high need.

Be open to all regardless of ability to pay.

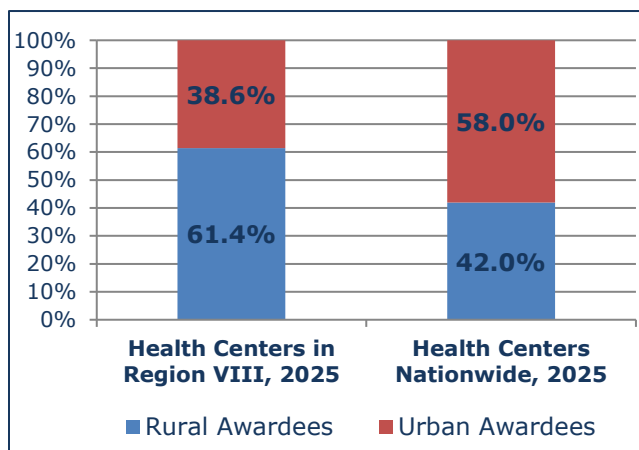
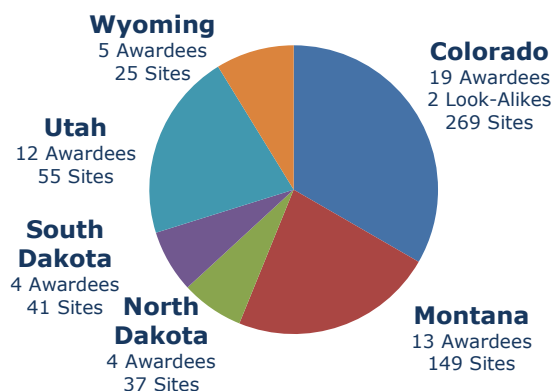
Provide services that fit the needs and priorities of the community.

Provide high quality care and be dedicated to improving patient outcomes.

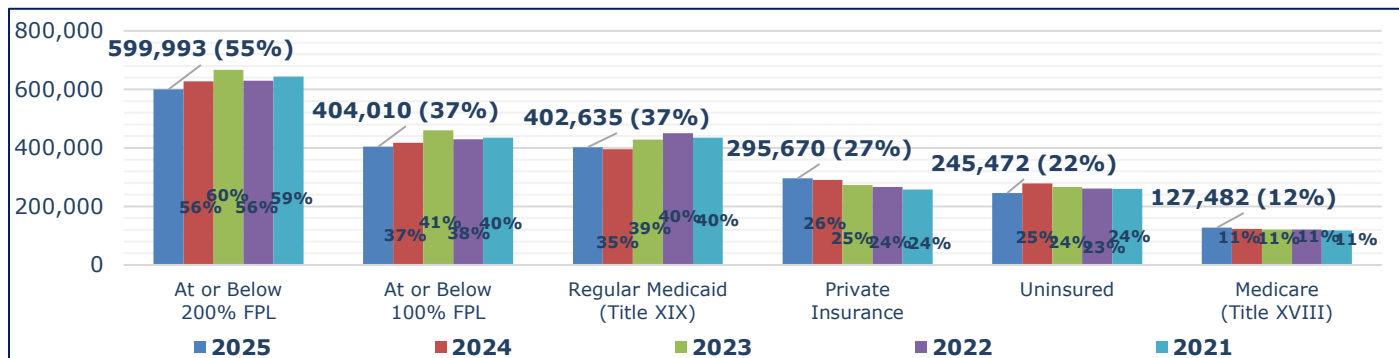
LOCATION OF REGION VIII HEALTH CENTERS

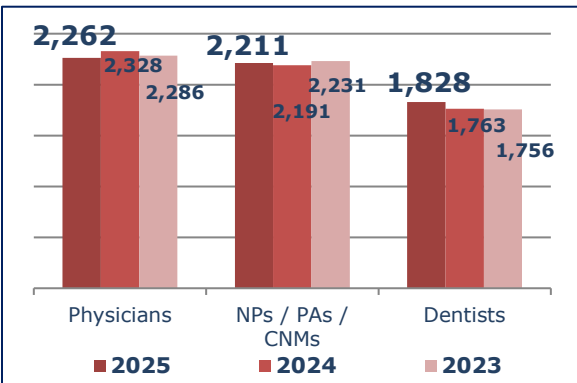

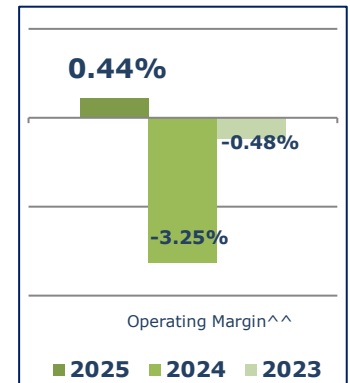
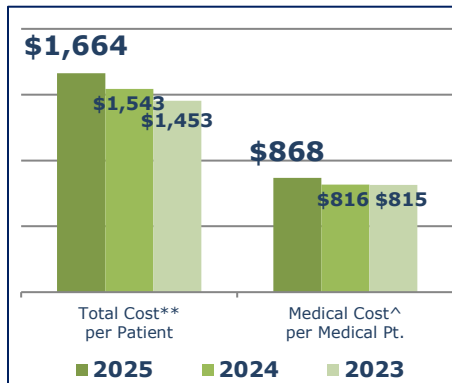

REGION VIII MEDICAL/DENTAL PRODUCTIVITY (VISITS/FTE)

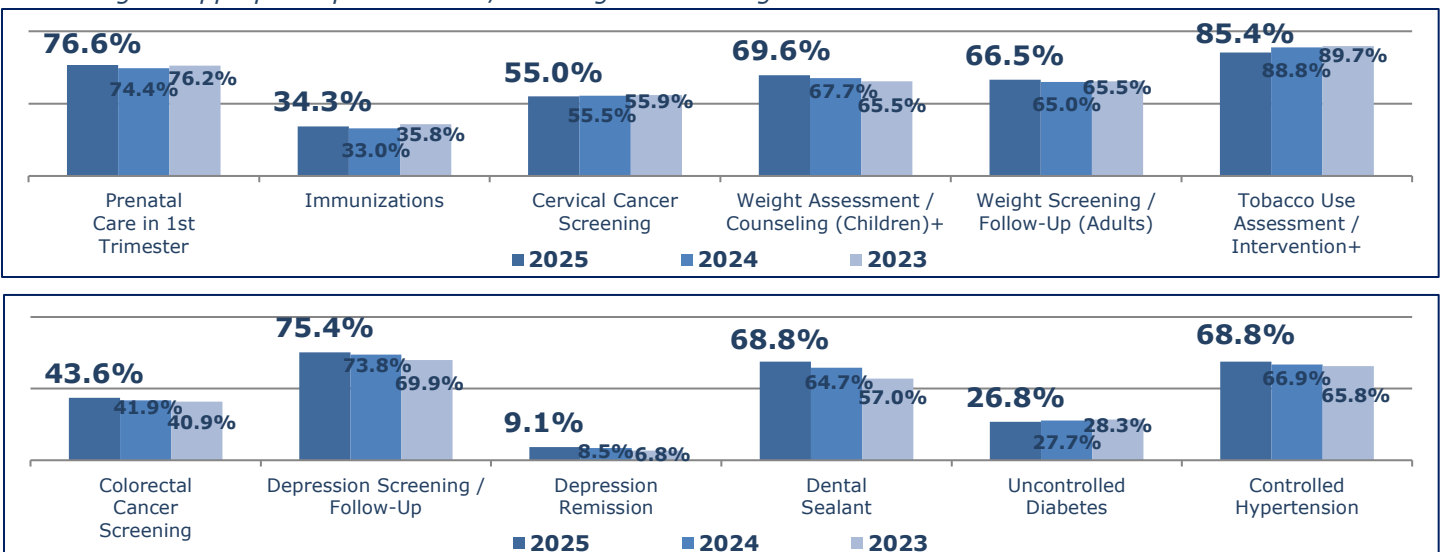
